Our legal team monitors BLM to ensure lawful planning and adherence to regulations regarding public comment. No back-door deals with anti-access groups!

ORBA will conduct seminars to educate OHV related businesses in Nevada about the importance of participating in the land use planning efforts for the State.

RECREATIONAL ACCESS IN NEVADA THREATENED AS NEVER BEFORE

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has announced that they will be developing new land management plans for the millions of acres that they manage within the State of Nevada. Without a coordinated effort, access to these scenic public lands could be lost forever.

- Radical anti-access groups have targeted most of Nevada for closure to mountain bikes and motorized vehicles.
- In addition so-called “environmental” groups have targeted millions more acres for closure as endangered species habitat.
- The BLM admits that their road and trail inventory is woefully inaccurate. Current inventory may miss over 75% of current active roads and trails.
- There is a disturbing trend against organized group activities such as club rides and outright hostility toward competitive events.
- Radical anti-access organizations are targeting YOUR favorite roads and trails for immediate closure.

ORBA’S EXPERTISE

ORBA’s experienced staff will organize off-highway related businesses in the State of Nevada to play an active role in supporting the effort to make sure that the new land management plans being developed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in Nevada recognize the need for protecting OHV recreation in the State.

Although late in entering the California battles, ORBA’s professional staff has been involved for years in the planning process in California and can provide Nevada planners with significant advice on how to prevent the mistakes made in California. Reasonable environmental protection can be provided in land management plans without sacrificing public use of public lands. Management by “closure” and management by “litigation” are not necessary to land planning efforts!
